

Recommendations for Controlling Costs when Switching to the Keurig[®] Brew System

This information is based on pilot programs conducted at TBC's retail stores where customers consumed 12 K-Cups[®] per day with an average car count of 20 cars per day. We recommend adjusting quantities for your particular store based upon your average car count.

Step 1: Get set up with an Office Depot account and receive item #325906 (Coffee Pod Drawer) pictured below for \$15.22, retail value of \$20 - \$30 (Amazon).

The more K-Cups your customers see, the more they will use so limit your K-Cup drawer to 20 K-Cups per day. Place unopened boxes of K-Cups out of sight in a storage closet.

- Step 2: Limit your supply orders to 4 cases of K-Cups per month. There are 96 K-Cups per case, totaling 384 K-Cup servings per month. You should only need 6 - 8 creamer and sugar canisters per month in the summer months and 12 creamer and sugar canisters in the winter months.
- Step 3: Limit your K-Cup offering to 2 blends of regular coffee K-Cups (no decaf) and remove tea and hot chocolate, if you currently offer it.
